RDC XI Resolution No. 60, Series of 2009

Adopting the Integrity Development Action Plan (IDAP) for Implementation in the Region

Whereas, the Integrity Development Action Plan, showcasing the government's efforts towards addressing the problem on graft and corruption was presented before this Council by Secretary Constanca P. de Guzman of the Presidential Anti-Graft Commission (PAGC) of the Office of the President of the Philippines;

Whereas, IDAP which was adopted as the National Anti-Corruption Framework of the Executive Branch is composed of 22 specific anti-corruption measures clustered into strategies on prevention, education, investigation and enforcement, and strategic partnership;

Whereas, IDAP shall be institutionalized and sustained at the Agency Regional Offices and Local Government Units;

Whereas, the Council has determined the same is consistent with the Medium-Term Philippine Development Plan (MTPDP) 2004-2010 which calls for a collective front against graft and corruption; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that this Council adopt the Integrated Development Action Plan for implementation in the region.

Resolved, further, that a copy of this Resolution be provided to the Presidential Anti-Graft Commission and all concerned agencies and local governments for their information and appropriate action.
