**IDC XI Resolution No. 07, Series of 2006**

**Endorsing to RDC XI for Approval the proposed projects of the Municipality of San Isidro, Davao Oriental, for funding under the EPIRA Fund**

*Whereas*, Section 66 of Republic Act No. 9136, otherwise known as the Electric Power Industry Reform Act (EPIRA), reaffirms that host local government units of energy generating projects be provided with a minimum set of monetary and non monetary benefits as well as certain preferences;

*Whereas*, The host region of the generating facility is also provided with monetary benefits in accordance to the guidelines set for this purpose;

*Whereas*, As of December 2005, Davao Region's accumulated share under this fund from 1994 to 2005 amounts to ₱ 2,210,554.36 for the Development and Livelihood Fund (DLF) and P 759,946.27 for the reforestation, watershed management, health and environment enhancement fund (RWMHEEF);

*Whereas*, In accordance with the guidelines for the utilization of the EPIRA fund, the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) XI, as the Secretariat of the Regional Development Council (RDC) XI, informed and encouraged the Local Government Units (LGUs) in Davao Region to submit project proposals that would qualify for funding under the EPIRA Fund;

*Whereas*, The Municipality of San Isidro, Davao Oriental, submitted the following development and livelihood projects for possible funding under the regional share of the EPIRA Fund:
