**IDC XI Resolution No. 05, Series of 2008**

**Endorsing to the RDC XI for Approval the Conduct of Preliminary Study to Determine the Technical and Economic Feasibility of Making Mati Wharf as the Hub in the Transport of Mineral Resources of Davao Region**

*Whereas*, The Davao Oriental Eastern Chamber of Commerce and Industry proposed to declare and develop Mati Wharf as the Hub for the Transport of Mineral Resources of Davao Region particularly considering the development of Mati City's vast mineral based resources, as well as the increasing number of possible investors, both local and foreign;

*Whereas*, The Mati Wharf is classified as a common user port for general cargoes under the jurisdiction of the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA);

*Whereas*, The Mati Wharf, as a transshipment port of mineral resources requires special port equipment and facilities;

*Whereas*, The Infrastructure Development Committee (IDC) XI finds the need to conduct a preliminary study to determine the technical and economic feasibility of the proposal so that further evaluation can be made; now therefore be it

*Resolved, as it is hereby resolved*, That the IDC XI endorse to the Regional Development Council (RDC) XI for approval the conduct of preliminary study to determine the technical and economic feasibility of declaring and developing Mati Wharf as the hub in the transport of mineral resources of Davao Region:


