IDC XI Resolution No. 03, Series of 2009

Endorsing to the RDC XI for Approval, the Inclusion of Four Bridge Projects in the DPWH Bridge Replacement Project to be Financed by the Governments of the Philippines and United Kingdom

Whereas, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) pre-qualified and submitted for RDC XI's approval, the inclusion of proposed four bridges in the DPWH Bridge Replacement Project to be financed by the Governments of the Philippines and United Kingdom;

Whereas, the proposed bridge projects aim to improve Davao Region's existing road network by replacing damaged bridges and converting temporary bridges to permanent ones thereby providing better access and linkage within and outside of the region;

Whereas, the Infrastructure Development Committee (IDC) XI finds the replacement of the proposed bridge projects consistent with the thrusts and priorities of the region in promoting greater economic opportunities and faster delivery of basic social services and ensuring the safety of the motorists and the public, in general; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the IDC XI endorse to the Regional Development Council (RDC) XI for approval, the inclusion the following four (4) bridge projects in the DPWH Bridge Replacement Project to be financed by the Governments of the Philippines and United Kingdom, viz:

1. Malabog (bailey) Bridge, Malabog, Davao City
2. Mabuyong Bridge, Cateel, Davao Oriental
3. Kalaw Bridge, Monkayo, Compostela Valley
4. Mangalcal Bridge, Carmen, Davao del Norte

Resolved, that DPWH and the concerned local government units shall ensure the acquisition of the required right-of-way on all proposed bridge replacement projects before the start of the civil works.

Resolved further, that DPWH shall conduct a study (in consultation with the concerned LGU and other stakeholders) to determine the cost effective option of replacing Kalaw Bridge taking into consideration the presence of the newly constructed By-Pass Road.

Resolved furthermore, that DPWH and the concerned local government units shall provide appropriate structural and bioengineering methods of river training works and erosion protection to ensure that the rivers will not erode the banks which may pose danger to the stability of the bridge structures or in the event that the river may shift course and cut a new channel across the road.


Resolved finally, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Department of Public Works and Highways (Regional and Central Offices), City Government of Davao, Municipal Governments of Cateel, Monkayo and Carmen and the Provincial Governments of Davao Oriental, Davao del Norte and Compostela Valley, for information and appropriate action.
