**Resolution No. 2, Series of 1999**

**Urging the RDC XI to Request the Philippine Ports Authority to Give Priority to the Development of Davao City's Sasa and Sta. Ana Wharves**

**WHEREAS**, this Committee sees the upgrading and expansion of Davao City's Sasa and Sta. Ana Wharves as a critical need in the aspired fast-tracking of the region's development;

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Ports Authority, which plans and programs the upgrading and development of all national port facilities, has not initiated any move toward the upgrading and/or expansion of these important wharves;

**WHEREAS**, this Committee recognizes its advocacy role in the region's push for a better market environment for its agricultural and manufacturing produce; and higher-capacity and better-equipped seaports are among the essential requisites of such an envisioned market environment;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, that this Committee urge the Regional Development Council XI to request the National Government, particularly the Philippine Ports Authority, to give priority to the development of Davao City's Sasa and Sta. Ana Wharves so that the region's development may be fast-tracked.
